## **Community Volunteers/ Help Wanted/ Donations Needed**

Mutual Aid Weekly Food Distribution: Our local community immigrant families continue to struggle during this COVID pandemic; often essential workers, they do not receive the necessary support both from a safety and financial perspective. Rural Resistance Placerville, in partnership with the SOL Community Farmer's Market, continues to coordinate a weekly food and supplies distribution to support these local Black, Indigenous, People of Color (BIPOC) families.

We are collecting food, supplies and \$ donations for this effort. To donate food and supplies, there is a weekly collection every Friday at Raley's on Placerville Dr. from 9-11am in the parking lot, near the gas station.
